1.	<p>On page no. 8 in Scope of work, Point No. D, there is mention of - Market Analysis for Orange or Mandarin Processed Products with help of stakeholder consultation and Discussion/dialog with mandarin growers/ Farmers Producer Companies/co-operatives working in the field of orange processing and other related stakeholder</p> <p>In this point, there should be mention of number of respondents, i.e. mandarin growers/ Farmers Producer Companies/co-operatives to be covered. This will be required to compare the quotes of bidders on same parameters. The coverage and number of respondents will be different for different bidders as per their methodology. The pre-defined coverage and number of respondents will bring all the bidders on the same level with respect to technical aspects.</p>	<p>No change in clause. The approach and methodology has allotted marks.</p>
2.	<p>On page no. 8 in Scope of work, Point No. E in Technical feasibility: For Processing Unit, there is no mention of product-wise capacity and approximate investment in the proposed project. What is the maximum ceiling of estimated project cost or capacity of the proposed project and proposed means of Finance?</p>	<p>The bidder is to suggest the capacity, estimated project cost, means of finance by conducting the study in the DFR.</p>
3.	<p>On page no. 9 in Scope of work, Point No. G in Promoters and Management: There is mention of various aspects of Promoters like Existing strengths and weaknesses of the promoters. For this requisite details of Promoters are required.</p>	<p>The selected bidder has to discuss with Promoter and find out their strengths and weaknesses.</p>
4.	<p>On page no. 10 in Payment Terms and Deliverables: There is no mention of advance payment, also first payment against inception report is also only 10% and draft DFR only 30%. Major payment of 60% is against submission of Final DFR. For inception report, please make the payment of 30%, for draft DFR 40% and for final DFR 30%, as there will be major</p>	<p>No change in the payment terms and deliverables. The payment to the selected bidder will be done by MSAMB.</p>

	cost involved in field work and resources for preparation of draft DFR. Also please confirm that all payment will be done by MSAMB and not the Vidarbha Agrovision Producers Company Ltd (VAPCO).

On page no. 10 in Eligibility Criteria-Point No.2 and also in Page no. 14 & 15 in Procedure for Selection: The average annual turnover in advisory related projects in agro processing sector of the bidder/agencies for the last three financial years ending on March 31 st 2021 should be equal to or greater than Rs. 5 Crores. Whether Sugarcane processing / sugar industry and grain based alcohol industry and environment related services for such industry or other food processing industry will be considered for this criteria? Also it is requested to reduce the turnover criteria to Rs. 50 lakh as the proposed project will not be having large scale or Mega Project scale investment.	No change in clause.
