





# Weekly Price of Maize By the end of 08 June 2025 : ₹ 2100 /Qtl.










- Last week, in Nandgaon Market the price was Rs. 2100 per quintal. The price has increased compared to last week.
- The Minimum Support Price for Kharif season 2025-26 has been declared as Rs.2400 per quintal.
- At present, the price of maize is lower than MSP (2024-25).
- Compared to the previous week, the arrival of maize at the national level has decreased by 25.75 and state level has increased by 26.60 %.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Maize at Rs.2126 per quintal in Amalner market, while the Jalna market observed the lowest price at Rs. 1940 per quintal.






The average prices of Gram in last week was Rs. 5458 per quintal in Latur market.Prices increased by 5% as compare to its previous week.

The MSP of Gram for Rabi season 2024-25 is Rs. 5650/Qtl




There has been 26 % decrease in the arrival of gram at national level compared to the previous week.






The MSP for Kharif 2024-25 is Rs. 7550/Qtl while GOI declare kharip MSP for the season 2025-26 is 8000/Qtl.


There has been 16 % decrease in the arrivals of Tur at national level compared to the previous week.





## Soybean Weekly Prices Weekending 08 Jun 2025 :Rs.4190/qtl.











- The average prices of soybean in last week was Rs. 4190 per quintal in Latur market. Prices decreased by 1% as compare to its previous week.


# Weekly Price of Cotton By the end of 08 June 2025: ₹ 7,525 /qtl.

- During the last week, the highest average price of Cotton at Rs. 7800 / quintal in Amravti market, while the Savner (Nagpur) market observed the lowest price at Rs. 7400 / quintal.







## **Onion Weekly Prices**

Weekending 08 June 2025: Rs. 1424 Per qtl.










- -The average price of onion in the Lasalgoan market was Rs.1424 per quintal last week, Prices increased by 5 percent as compared to the previous week.




### **Tomato Weekly Prices**

- The highest average prices received in Mumbai market (Rs.1760/quintal) and lowest price received in the Solapur market (Rs.960/quintal)






### **Weekly Prices of Turmeric**

- Last week, in Hingoli Market the price was Rs. 12094 / per quintal.
   The price has increased compared to last week.
- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of turmeric at the national level and state have increased by 17.57 % and 8.47 % respectively.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs.13325/quintal in Sangali market, while the Washim market observed the lowest price at Rs. 11445/qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 to 2031.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the year 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
