





Weekly Price of Maize By the end of 22 June 2025 : ₹ 1970 /Qtl.











- Last week, in Nandgaon Market the price was Rs. 1970 per quintal. The price has decreased compared to last week.
- The Minimum Support Price for Kharif season 2025-26 has been declared as Rs.2400 per quintal.
- At present, the price of maize is lower than MSP (2024-25).
- Compared to the previous week, the arrival of maize at the national level has increased by 44.58 % and state level has decreased by 55.90 %.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Maize at Rs.2164 per quintal in Amalner market, while the Chh. Sambhajinagar market observed the lowest price at Rs. 1938 per quintal.




The average prices of Gram in last week was Rs. 5488 per quintal in Latur market. Prices increase by 0.7% as compare to its previous week.








Soybean Weekly Prices Weekending 22 Jun 2025: Rs.4288/qtl.











- The average prices of soybean in last week was Rs. 4288 per quintal in Latur market. Prices increased by 3.7% as compare to its previous week.
- The MSP for Kharif 2024-25 is Rs. 4892 per quintal. The current prices of soyeban are lower than the MSP. Recently GOI declare MSP Rs. 5328 /qtl for the marketing year 2025-26.
- The arrivals of soybean have been decreased by 4 percent at national level as compare to last week.
- During the last week, the highest average prices of soybean at Rs. 4763 per quintal in the Washim market, while the lowest price at Rs. 4156 per qtl. observed in the Indore (MP) market.


Weekly Price of Cotton By the end of 22 June 2025: ₹ 7,758 /qtl.

- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of Cotton at the national and state leve have decreased by 23.18 % and 2.60 % respectively.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Cotton at Rs. 8150 / quintal in Akot (Akola) market, while the Kalmeshwar (Nagpur) market observed the lowest price at Rs. 7300 / quintal.








Weekending 22 June 2025: Rs. 1582 Per qtl.










- -The average price of onion in the Lasalgoan market was Rs. 1582 per quintal last week, Prices decreased by 1 percent as compared to the previous week.





- The highest average prices received in Mumbai market (Rs.1840/quintal) and lowest price received in the Solapur market (Rs.1000/quintal)






Weekly Prices of Turmeric

- Last week, in Hingoli Market the price was Rs. 11690 / per quintal. The price has decreased compared to last week.
- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of turmeric at the national level has increased by 2.33 % and state level has decreased by 1.12 %.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs.12763/quintal in Sangali market, while the Washim market observed the lowest price at Rs. 11150 / qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 to 2031.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the year 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
