





Weekly Price of Maize By the end of 27 April 2025 : ₹ 2150 /Qtl.










- Last week, in Nandgaon Market the price was Rs.2150 per quintal. The price has same compared to last week.






Gram Production in India is likely to be less than the previous year

This week's gram prices in Latur market appear to have decreased compared to last week.




The MSP of Gram for Rabi season 2024-25 is Rs. 5650/Qtl





There has been 19.74 % decrease in the arrival of gram at national level compared to the previous week.

Current Prices are lower than MSP.




There has been 5.79 % decrease in the arrivals of Tur at national level compared to the previous week.



Soybean Weekly Prices Weekending 27 April 2025 :Rs.4356/qtl.











- The average prices of soybean in last week was Rs. 4356 per quintal in Latur market. Prices decreased by 3.2 % as compare to its previous week.


Weekly Price of Cotton By the end of 27 April 2025: ₹ 7,269 /qtl.







Onion Weekly Prices






Tomato Weekly Prices






Weekly Prices of Turmeric

- Last week, in Hingoli Market the price was Rs. 12950 / per quintal. The price has decreased compared to last week.

- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs.15600/quintal in Sangali market, while the Hingoli market observed the lowest price at Rs. 12950/qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 to 2031.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the year 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
