

Weekly Prices of Maize in Nandgaon (Rs/Qtl)



- Last week, in Nandgaon Market the price was Rs.2150 per quintal. The price has increased compared to last week.


- The Minimum Support Price for Kharif season 2024-25 is Rs. 2225 per quintal.

- At present, the price of maize is lower than MSP.


- Compared to the previous week, the arrival of maize at the national level and state level has decreased by 25.98 % and 51.59 % respectively.




Soybean Weekly Prices

Weekending 29th December 2024 :Rs.4092/qtl.


- The average prices of soybean was Rs. 4092 per quintal in Latur market. Prices decreased slightly by 0.2 % as compare to last week.

- The MSP for Kharif 2024-25 is Rs. 4892 per quintal. The current prices of soybean are lower than the MSP.



- The arrivals of soybean has been decreased by 26 percent at national level as compare to last week.

- During the last week, the highest average price of soybean at Rs.4280 per quintal in the Washim markets, while the lowest price at Rs. 3983/qtl. observed in the Amravati market.









India's cotton production for the 2024-25 season is forecast to drop by 7.4% to 30.2 million bales due to reduced planted area and crop damage from excessive rainfall.


The USDA also revised its India production forecast down to 30.72 million bales, further tightening supply.

This decline in domestic production is expected to reduce exports and increase the need for imports, which are projected to rise to 2.5 million bales from 1.75 million bales in the previous year.


Cotton production is projected to increase in China, Brazil, and Argentina, more than offsetting reductions in the US and Spain (Source – USDA)



Weekly Prices of Turmeric in Basmat Market (Rs. per Quintal)




- Last week, in Basamat Market the price was Rs. 12700/- per quintal. The price has increased compared to last week.
- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of Turmeric at the national level have increased by 1.45 %, and at the state level, they have decreased by 0.24 %.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs. 12738 / quintal in Nanded market, while the Washim market observed the lowest price at Rs. 12000 / qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 and 2031.
- The global production of turmeric is around 11 lakh tonnes per annum. India dominates the world production scenario contributing 80% followed by China (8%), Myanmar (4%), Nigeria (3%) and Bangladesh (3%).
- In 2023-24, India had exported 1.62 lakh tonnes of turmeric compared to 1.70 lakh tonnes in the previous year.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the years 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
